AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses of
the Controller of County Accounts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six,
7 to wit: —

8 For the salary of the controller of county ac-
9 counts, twenty-five hundred dollars. [Acts 1887,
10 chap. 438; 1890, chap. 306.]

(Appropriation, 1895, \$2,500.)

11 For the salary of the first deputy of the con-
12 troller of county accounts, eighteen hundred dol-
13 lars. [Acts 1887, chap. 438; 1890, chap. 306;
14 1895, chap. 175.]

(Appropriation, 1895, \$1,800.)

15 For the salary of the second deputy of the con-
16 troller of county accounts, fifteen hundred dollars.

17 [Acts 1887, chap. 438; 1890, chap. 306.]

(Appropriation, \$1895, 1,500.)

18 For travelling and office expenses of the con-
19 troller of county accounts, and of his deputies, a
20 sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars. [Res.

21 1856, chap. 74; Acts 1887, chap. 438.]

(Appropriation, 1895, \$1,500.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
