AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Expenses of the Free Public Library Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
7 six, to wit:—

8 To carry out the provisions of the act to pro-
9 mote the establishment and efficiency of free
10 public libraries, under the direction of the free
11 public library commission, a sum not exceeding
12 three thousand dollars. [Acts 1890, chap. 347.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$3,000.)

13 For clerical assistance, incidental and necessary
14 expenses of the free public library commission, a

15 sum not exceeding five hundred dollars. [Acts
16 1890, chap. 347.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$500.)

1 SECT. 2. This act takes effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
