AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Massachusetts School Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of one hundred thousand
2 dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the or-
4 dinary revenue, for the Massachusetts school
5 fund, as provided for by chapter ninety of the re-
6 solves of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
7 four.

(Appropriation, 1895, \$100,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
