In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-six.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Removal of Wrecks  
from Tide Waters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of five thousand dollars  
2 is hereby appropriated to be paid out of the  
3 treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordin-  
4 ary revenue, for expenses in connection with the  
5 removal of wrecks and other obstructions from  
6 tide waters, as provided for in section nine of  
7 chapter two hundred and sixty of the acts of the  
8 year eighteen hundred and eighty-three, during  
9 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-  
10 ber in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

(Appropriation 1895, \$5,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
