### AN ACT

Authorizing Holders of Liquor Licenses to carry on their  
Business on Certain Legal Holidays.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Persons duly licensed to sell intoxicating  
2 liquors may sell the same on any legal holiday except  
3 Christmas day and the day of a national, state, munici-  
4 pal or annual town election. In licenses hereafter issued  
5 the sale of liquors on such legal holidays shall not be  
6 declared to be a cause for the forfeiture of the license.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts which pre-  
2 scribe a penalty for the sale of liquor on legal holidays,  
3 except the day of a national, state, municipal or annual  
4 town election, are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
