AN ACT

Relative to notifying Attorneys of Trials.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The clerks of the superior court for civil
2 business in the several counties of the Commonwealth
3 shall, twenty-four hours at least before an action shall be
4 in order for trial, send, by mail or otherwise, a notice
5 thereof to the attorneys of record in said action, and if
6 there be no attorneys of record the said notice shall be
7 sent to the parties to the action.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on the first day of
2 September in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.
