

HOUSE No. 820.

[Bill accompanying the petition of the Selectmen of Stoneham. Metropolitan Affairs.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-six.

AN ACT

In regard to Highways in the Town of Stoneham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Wherever the metropolitan park com-
2 missioners, acting under the authority of chapter four
3 hundred and seven of the acts of eighteen hundred and
4 ninety-three, have taken or shall take, by purchase or
5 otherwise, lands within the territory of the town of
6 Stoneham upon both sides of a county or town way,
7 the said commissioners shall take charge of such por-
8 tions of said way as lie wholly between the lands so
9 taken by them, and file a plan thereof in the office of
10 the county commissions of the county of Middlesex,
11 and shall file a copy thereof in the clerk's office of the

12 town of Stoneham, and said way shall be thereafter kept
13 in repair by said commissioners at the expense of said
14 Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 2. Said commissioners may widen and improve
2 said ways and may establish and maintain watering
3 troughs at suitable places along said ways.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
