### AN ACT

Relating to the Widening of Tremont and Boylston Streets  
in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of street commissioners of  
2 the city of Boston, with the approval of the mayor, may  
3 after the notice and hearing required in the laying out  
4 of streets in the city of Boston, pass an order for the  
5 widening of Tremont street and Boylston street, in said  
6 city, from the present westerly line of Tremont street  
7 and the northerly line of Boylston street over so much  
8 of the ground occupied by the subway as it shall deem  
9 the public interest and necessity shall require, and on  
10 the recording of such order in the books of said city  
11 said streets shall be widened in accordance therewith.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
