AN ACT

Providing for Printing Additional Copies of the Report of
the Treasurer and Receiver-General.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There shall be printed for the use of the
2 treasurer and receiver-general four hundred copies of his
3 report in addition to the number now authorized by law.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
