AN ACT

Relative to Agents of the State Board of Education.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No agent of the state board of education  
2 shall be pecuniarily interested, either directly or indirectly,  
3 in the publication or sale of any text book, school book  
4 or article of school supply, used in the public schools of  
5 this Commonwealth.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect January first,  
2 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.
