### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Malden to incur Additional  
Indebtedness for Sewerage Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purposes specified in  
2 chapter one hundred and eighty-eight of the acts  
3 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety, the city  
4 of Malden may issue scrip or bonds to an amount  
5 not exceeding six hundred and fifty thousand  
6 dollars.

7 Excepting as to the amount, the provisions of  
8 said chapter one hundred and eighty-eight shall  
9 apply to the bonds hereby authorized to be issued.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
