[To accompany the petition of Josiah Quincy for legislation fixing the rate of interest to be paid on bonds issued by the City of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.]

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-six.

AN ACT

Relating to the Interest on Bonds of the City of
Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All notes, bonds or scrip of the
2 city of Boston, whether heretofore or hereafter
3 authorized by the legislature or the city council
4 of said city, shall bear interest at such rate, and
5 said interest shall be payable semi-annually at
6 such times, as shall be determined by the city
7 treasurer of said city at the time of issuing the
8 same.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
