### AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Falmouth to Construct  
and Maintain Bridges in said Town.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 The town of Falmouth may lay out a town way  
2 or highway in said town over the creek running  
3 into Buzzard's bay and known as Herring river  
4 and also over the creek running into Wild harbor,  
5 and may also build and maintain a bridge over  
6 each of said creeks, subject to the provisions of  
7 chapters nineteen and forty-nine of the Public  
8 Statutes and of any other laws which now are or  
9 hereafter may be in force applicable thereto.
