AN ACT

To confirm the Proceedings of the Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Shirley.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The proceedings of the annual
2 town meeting of the town of Shirley, held on the
3 sixteenth day of March in the year eighteen hun-
4 dred and ninety-six, shall not be invalid by reason
5 of the omission in the warrant calling such meet-
6 ing of a specific article for acceptance of town
7 by-laws.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
