In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To authorize the sale of Certain Land taken for Public Park Purposes in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of park commissioners
2 of the city of Boston is hereby authorized, with
3 the approval of the mayor of said city, to sell a
4 parcel of land containing nine hundred twenty-
5 one and eight-tenths square feet, situated on the
6 northwesterly side of the Back Bay fens, at the
7 junction of Audubon road and Peterborough
8 street, in said city, and to apply the proceeds of
9 the sale to the payment of other lands taken by
10 said city for park purposes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
