In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To authorize Cities to Pension Firemen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any city may, by vote of its city council
2 and under such restrictions and subject to such provisions
3 as may be prescribed by such vote or by ordinance,
4 pension any fireman not less than sixty years of age,
5 who has been continuously in the service of such city as
6 a regular member of the fire department for not less than
7 twenty years prior to the passage of such vote, and who,
8 by reason of disability or infirmity is no longer able to
9 perform active service as such fireman.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
