AN ACT

To authorize the Boston Pneumatic Transit Company to lay its Tubes across Fort Point Channel and Charles River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Boston Pneumatic Transit
2 Company is hereby authorized to lay and main-
3 tain its tubes and such structures and apparatus
4 as may be necessary to cover and carry the same
5 across Fort Point channel, under and by the side
6 of Dover street bridge in the city of Boston, and
7 also across the Charles river under and by the
8 side of Harvard bridge and Warren bridge over
9 said river, subject to the provisions of chapter
10 nineteen of the Public Statutes and all acts in
11 amendment thereof and addition thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
