### RESOLVE

In favor of Frank L. Garland.

1 *Resolved*, That an annuity of six hundred dollars be  
2 allowed and paid from the treasury of the Common-  
3 wealth to Frank L. Garland of Concord, for the term of  
4 his natural life, as compensation for injuries received by  
5 him while in the discharge of his duties as an officer at  
6 the Massachusetts reformatory.
