In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

Relative to the Public Health in Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter seventy-four
2 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety,
3 entitled: "An act in relation to public health in cities,"
4 shall apply to such towns of more than five thousand
5 population as shall vote in a duly called town meeting to
6 accept the provisions of said act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
