RESOLVE

Providing for the Making of Surveys and Plans of the State House Grounds and Adjacent Land and Buildings.

1 *Resolved*, That the state house committee be au-
2 thorized to employ the services of a competent engi-
3 neer, at an expense not exceeding four thousand dollars,
4 to make an accurate survey of the property owned by
5 the Commonwealth, and such adjacent property in the
6 vicinity of the state house as may appear necessary to
7 include in such survey, and furnish maps and estimates
8 for changing of the grades of streets in the immediate
9 vicinity of the state house, and to furnish a perspective
10 plan of the state house and grounds and adjacent build-
11 ings, said surveys, plans and perspectives being consid-
12 ered necessary by the state house committee to enable
13 them to intelligently report on so much of the governor's
14 annual address as relates to high buildings in the vicinity
15 of the state house, and also to report on the annual
16 report of the state house construction commission, and
17 certain recommendations made therein.
