### AN ACT

To extend the Time within which the Town of Holden  
may supply Itself with Water.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter one  
2 hundred and eighty of the acts of the year  
3 eighteen hundred and ninety-six are hereby ex-  
4 tended for the period of three years from and  
5 after the twenty-first day of March in the year  
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
