

# SENATE . . . . . No. 238.

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[To accompany the petition of the selectmen of the town of Milton for legislation to ratify and confirm the laying out, widening and altering of certain streets in said town. Joint Judiciary.]

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## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

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### AN ACT

To ratify and confirm the Laying Out, Widening and Altering of Certain Streets, Ways and Highways, and the Laying Out of Special Spaces Therein for the use of Street Railway Companies in the Town of Milton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The laying out, alteration and  
2 widening of Brook road, Eliot street, Reedsdale  
3 road, Quarry street, Pleasant street, Edge Hill  
4 road, White street and Randolph avenue in the  
5 town of Milton, and a new street between Edge  
6 Hill road and Bryant avenue, and the laying out  
7 of special spaces for street railway use in the said

8 ways and highways, and all the proceedings of  
9 the town of Milton and its selectmen and com-  
10 mittees and officers, and of the county commis-  
11 sioners of Norfolk county in connection there-  
12 with and relation thereto, and especially the  
13 alterations and changes in widening Edge Hill  
14 road and in laying out the special space therein  
15 made by the selectmen and the special committee  
16 appointed by the town at its annual meeting in  
17 March, 1898, are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
18 And the said several streets and ways as so laid  
19 out, altered and widened, with the said special  
20 reserved spaces therein, according to said pro-  
21 ceedings and the plans and descriptions accom-  
22 panying the same now filed in the registry of  
23 deeds of Norfolk county are declared to be as  
24 duly and lawfully established in all respects under  
25 the provisions of law authorizing the assessment  
26 of betterments as if the descriptions and plans of  
27 the lands purchased or taken in connection there-  
28 with had been duly filed as provided by chapter  
29 one hundred and thirty-four of the acts of the  
30 year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.

1 SECTION 2. Damages sustained by any person  
2 by such changes, layings out, alterations or widen-  
3 ings, may be recovered in the manner now pro-  
4 vided by law: *provided* application for a jury to  
5 assess the same be made at any time within one  
6 year from the passage of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
