RESOLVE

To provide for the Disposition of the Material of the Educational Museum.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding five
3 hundred dollars, to be expended under the direction of
4 the state board of education for the sale, loan to state
5 normal schools or other disposition in such manner as
6 not to cause a continuing expense to the Commonwealth,
7 of the educational material furnished by the Common-
8 wealth for the world's Columbian exposition at Chicago,
9 so as to insure the preservation of such portions of the
10 material as the said board deems it wise to preserve.
