In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

AN ACT

To give the Superior Court Equity Power in Cases of Taking or Sale of Real Estate for the Payment of Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section sixty-six of chapter twelve
2 of the Public Statutes is hereby amended by in-
3 serting in the second line of said section, after the
4 words "supreme judicial court" the words: — or
5 superior court, — so that the same as amended
6 shall read as follows: —

7 *Section 66.* In all cases of taking or sale of
8 real estate for the payment of taxes assessed
9 thereon, the supreme judicial court or superior
10 court shall have equity powers, if relief is sought
11 within five years from the taking or sale.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
