RESOLVE

To authorize the Treasurer and Receiver-General to borrow
Money in Anticipation of Revenue.

1 *Resolved*, That the treasurer and receiver-general be
2 and he is hereby authorized to borrow, in anticipation of
3 the receipts of the present year, such sums of money as
4 may from time to time be necessary for the payment of
5 the ordinary demands on the treasury, at any time before
6 the expiration of fifteen days after the meeting of the
7 next general court, at such rates of interest as shall be
8 found necessary; and that he repay any sums he may
9 borrow under this resolve as soon as money sufficient for
10 the purpose, and not otherwise appropriated, shall be
11 received into the treasury.
