AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses of the District Police.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber in the year nineteen hundred, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the chief of the district police,
8 a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars.

10 For the salary of the first clerk in the office of
11 the chief of the district police, fifteen hundred
12 dollars. [Acts 1890, chap. 137.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$1,500.)

13 For the salary of the second clerk in the office

14 of the chief of the district police, one thousand
15 dollars. [Acts 1892, chap. 249.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$1,000.)

16 For the salary of the clerk in the boiler inspec-
17 tion department of the district police, six hundred
18 dollars. [Acts 1898, chap. 219.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$600.)

19 For the compensation of the members of the
20 district police, a sum not exceeding seventy-one
21 thousand dollars. [Pub. Stats., chap. 103; Acts
22 1887, chaps. 127 and 256; 1888, chaps. 389 and
23 426; 1891, chaps. 302 and 357; 1892, chap. 249;
24 1894, chap. 281; 1895, chaps. 396 and 418; 1896,
25 chap. 546; 1898, chap. 261.]

26 For travelling expenses of the members of the
27 district police, a sum not exceeding twenty-three
28 thousand three hundred dollars. [Pub. Stats.,
29 chap. 103; Acts 1887, chap. 127.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$23,300.)

30 For incidental and contingent expenses of the
31 chief and members of the district police, a sum
32 not exceeding two thousand dollars. [Pub. Stats.,
33 chap. 103.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$2,000.)

34 For running expenses of the steamer Lexington,
35 to be used under the charge of the chief of the
36 district police, for the enforcement of the fish
37 laws, a sum not exceeding eight thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
