### AN ACT

Relative to Allowances from the Estates of Deceased Persons for the Care of Burial Lots.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Upon the petition of an executor, ad-  
2 ministrator or party in interest, the probate court may,  
3 after such notice to all parties in interest as it deems  
4 sufficient, or with the assent of the parties in interest,  
5 make, out of the estate held by the executor or adminis-  
6 trator, a reasonable allowance for the care or improve-  
7 ment of any burial lot or tomb belonging to the estate  
8 so held.

1 SECTION 2. The sum allowed as provided for in  
2 section one shall be conveyed in trust to the trustees of

3 the cemetery where the lot or tomb is, or to the city or  
4 town in which the cemetery is situated, or to any other  
5 person or body authorized by law to hold property in  
6 trust for the care and improvement of cemetery lots and  
7 tombs; and the income thereof, and that only, shall be  
8 applied to this purpose.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
