## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

### AN ACT

Relative to Grade Crossings in the Town of Salisbury.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and twenty-eight  
2 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety, and  
3 acts in amendment thereof, shall not for the period of  
4 four years after the passage of this act apply to the  
5 abolition of grade crossings in the town of Salisbury.

1 SECTION 2. The board of selectmen shall cause to be  
2 printed in the warrant to be used at the next annual  
3 town meeting the question: "Shall grade crossings be  
4 abolished within the limits of the town of Salisbury?"  
5 And if a majority of the legal voters taking part in said  
6 town meeting vote in the affirmative, then the selectmen  
7 may proceed in accordance with the provisions of said  
8 chapter four hundred and twenty-eight and acts in  
9 amendment thereof to cause the abolition of grade cross-  
10 ings within the town of Salisbury, and this act shall  
11 thereupon become void and of no effect.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
