### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Massachusetts Hospital for Consumptives and Tubercular Patients.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for  
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-  
6 ber in the year nineteen hundred, to wit: —

7 For the care and maintenance of the Massa-  
8 chusetts Hospital for Consumptives and Tuber-  
9 cular Patients, a sum not exceeding sixty thousand  
10 dollars. [Acts 1895, chap. 503.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$40,000.)

11 For the payment of bills incurred in excess of  
12 the appropriation therefor during the year eight-  
13 een hundred and ninety-nine, made necessary on  
14 account of free beds, a sum not exceeding twelve  
15 thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
