AN ACT

Relative to the Liability of Employers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter two hundred and seventy of the acts of the
2 year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven is hereby
3 amended by inserting after section six thereof a new sec-
4 tion, as follows:—

5 *Section 7.* Any person an employee of a sub-con-
6 tractor who is not employed strictly or continuously on
7 the works of the employer, or who is not continually un-
8 der the direction of the principal employer, his superin-
9 tendent or agent, shall be deemed not to be a fellow
10 servant of the employees of the principal contractor.
