AN ACT

To amend Chapter Four Hundred of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-nine relative to the Compensation of the Metropolitan Park Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section one of chapter four hundred of the
- 2 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out in lines five and six and
- 4 in lines twenty-eight and twenty-nine, respectively, the
- 5 words "for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine,"
- 6 so as to read as follows: -
- 7 Section 1. Section one of chapter four hundred and
- 8 seven of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
- 9 ninety-three is hereby amended by striking out the last
- 10 sentence and substituting the following: The members
- 11 of said board, or any of them, may receive such compen-

12 sation for their services as the governor, with the advice

13 and consent of the council, may authorize, and shall also

14 be allowed their travelling and other expenses incurred

15 in the discharge of their duties; and all sums so author-

16 ized and allowed shall be paid by the Commonwealth and

17 shall be a part of the expenses under this act, — so as to

18 read as follows: -

19 Section 1. The governor, by and with the advice and

20 consent of the council, shall appoint five persons, who

21 shall constitute a board to be known as the metropolitan

22 park commission. The members of this board shall

23 hold office respectively for the terms of one year, two

24 years, three years, four years and five years, beginning

25 with the first Monday in May in the year eighteen hun-

26 dred and ninety-three, and annually thereafter the gov-

27 ernor shall appoint as aforesaid one such commissioner,

28 to hold office for the term of five years, beginning with

29 the first Monday in May in the year of his appointment;

30 and if any vacancy occurs in said board by resignation

31 or otherwise the governor shall in like manner appoint a

32 commissioner for the residue of the term in which the

33 vacancy occurs, and may also remove any commissioner.

34 The members of said board, or any of them, may receive

35 such compensation for their services as the governor,

36 with the advice and consent of the council, may author-

37 ize, and shall also be allowed their travelling and other

38 expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties; and all

39 sums so authorized and allowed shall be paid by the

40 Commonwealth and shall be a part of the expenses under

41 this act.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
