AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Expenses in the Office of the Court of Registration.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber in the year nineteen hundred, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the judge of the court of
8 registration, the sum of four thousand five hun-
9 dred dollars. [Acts 1898, chap. 562.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$4,500.)

10 For the salary of the assistant judge of the
11 court of registration, four thousand dollars.
12 [Acts 1898, chap. 562.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$4,000.)

13 For the salary of the recorder of the court of

14 registration, four thousand five hundred dollars.

15 [Acts 1898, chap. 562.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$4,500.)

16 For assistance in the land office of the court of
17 registration, a sum not exceeding four thousand

18 dollars. [Acts 1898, chap. 562.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$3,500.)

19 For sheriffs' bills, advertising, surveying and
20 sundry incidental expenses, a sum not exceeding
21 four thousand dollars. [Acts 1898, chap. 562.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$3,925.)

22 For the examining of titles, a sum not exceed-
23 ing ten thousand dollars. [Acts 1898, chap.
24 562.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$12,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
