AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Massachusetts Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 to meet the expenses of the Massachusetts high-
5 way commission for the year ending on the
6 thirty-first day of December in the year nineteen
7 hundred, to wit:—

8 For the salaries of the Massachusetts highway
9 commission, the sum of six thousand dollars.
10 [Acts 1898, chap. 528.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$6,000.)

11 For the salaries of the engineers, clerks and
12 assistants in the office of the Massachusetts high-
13 way commission, a sum not exceeding seventeen

14 thousand and sixty dollars. [Acts 1898, chap.
15 528.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$17,060.)

16 For travelling and other expenses of the com-
17 missioners, printing, postage and necessary office
18 expenses, a sum not exceeding five thousand
19 four hundred and forty dollars. [Acts 1898,
20 chap. 528.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$5,440)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
