AN ACT

Making a Close Time of Three Years for Ruffed Grouse.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No ruffed grouse, commonly called
2 partridge, shall be taken or killed in this state
3 during three years from and including the fifteenth
4 day of September in the year nineteen hundred.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever violates the provisions of
2 this act shall be subject to the existing penalties
3 for taking or killing the said ruffed grouse in
4 close season.
