AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at the State Industrial School for Girls.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber in the year nineteen hundred, to wit: —

7 For the payment of salaries, wages and labor
8 at the state industrial school for girls, a sum not
9 exceeding fifteen thousand five hundred dollars.

(Appropriation 1899, \$14,250.)

11 For current expenses at the state industrial
12 school for girls, a sum not exceeding twenty-one
13 thousand and seventy-five dollars. [Pub. Stats.,
14 chap. 89.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$20,125.)

15 For expenses in connection with boarding out
16 younger girls from the state industrial school, to
17 include boarding and other expenses for girls on
18 probation, a sum not exceeding twenty-five hun-
19 dred dollars. [Acts 1895, chap. 428.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$2,500.)

20 For the education and instruction in the public
21 schools in any city or town in the Commonwealth
22 of children boarded or bound out by the trustees
23 of the Lyman and industrial schools, a sum not
24 exceeding one hundred and twenty-five dollars.
25 [Acts 1896, chap. 382.]

(Appropriation 1899, \$125.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
