AN ACT

Relative to the Setting of Nets in North River in the
County of Plymouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for any person
2 to set a net, or to fish with a net the meshes of
3 which are not less than two and one-half inches
4 in length, in North river, in the county of Ply-
5 mouth, at any place between the railroad bridge
6 of the New York, New Haven and Hartford
7 Railroad Company and the mouth of said river, at
8 any time between sunrise and sunset.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
