AN ACT

Relative to the Appointment of Officers in Cities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In any city which adopts the pro-  
2 visions of this act the mayor and aldermen shall  
3 appoint all officers required by the charter or  
4 ordinances of such city or the laws of the Com-  
5 monwealth, except so far as is otherwise provided  
6 in its charter; and such officers so appointed shall  
7 hold office respectively until they resign or are  
8 removed by the mayor, with the consent of the  
9 aldermen; but the provisions of this act shall not  
10 apply to officers to be appointed or elected under  
11 the laws of the Commonwealth relating to  
12 elections.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect in any  
2 city in which it is adopted by vote of the city  
3 council thereof, or of such board as has the  
4 powers of a city council.
