

HOUSE No. 477.

[Bill accompanying the petition of Warren F. Spalding. Cities.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

AN ACT

To provide for the Election of Aldermen in the City
of Cambridge for Two Years.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of aldermen of the city
2 of Cambridge shall be composed of one alderman
3 at large and two aldermen from each ward, all of
4 whom shall be elected by and from the qualified
5 voters of the whole city. At the next annual
6 municipal election, and thereafter at every alter-
7 nate municipal election, the alderman at large and
8 one alderman from each ward shall be elected for
9 two years. At said next municipal election one
10 alderman from each ward shall be elected for one
11 year; and thereafter, at every alternate municipal

12 election, one alderman from each ward shall be
13 elected for two years.

1 SECTION 2. So much of section two of chapter
2 three hundred and sixty-four of the acts of the
3 year eighteen hundred and ninety-one as is incon-
4 sistent herewith is hereby repealed.
