### AN ACT

Relative to Damages occasioned by the Construction of  
Basins or Reservoirs for Water Supply in the Town of  
Hopkinton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The treasurer of the Commonwealth shall  
2 pay as a part of the expenses of the metropolitan water  
3 works, to the town of Hopkinton so long as said town  
4 remains a municipality, the sum of three thousand dol-  
5 lars in the month of September in the year nineteen  
6 hundred, and the like sum in the same month in each  
7 succeeding year until ten years after the reservoirs or  
8 basins situated in said town of Hopkinton, cease to be a  
9 part of the metropolitan water system; but shall pay no  
10 tax and make no other payment to said town on account  
11 of any property held by said water board for the pur-  
12 poses of a water supply.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
