

HOUSE No. 798.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

AN ACT

Relative to the Compensation of Agents employed to protect Sources of Water Supply from Pollution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter five hundred and ten of the acts
2 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven is hereby
3 amended by striking out all of section two of said act
4 after the word "board," in the thirteenth line of said
5 section, and by inserting instead thereof the words:—
6 and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth,—
7 so that the same shall read as follows:—
8 *Section 2.* Said board shall appoint such agents and
9 servants as it may deem necessary, who shall attend to
10 the enforcement of the provisions of this act and of the
11 rules, regulations and orders thereunder, and shall have

12 the power, by such agents and servants as aforesaid, to
13 enter into and upon any building, structure and prem-
14 ises for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not any
15 sources of pollution or danger to the water supply there
16 exist, and whether or not the provisions of this act
17 and of the rules, regulations and orders made as afore-
18 said are complied with and obeyed. Such agents and
19 servants shall receive a reasonable compensation for their
20 services to be fixed by said board and paid out of the
21 treasury of the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
