In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

AN ACT

To authorize the Greenfield Electric Light and Power Company to do Business in the Towns of Shelburne, Buckland and Conway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Greenfield Electric Light
2 and Power Company, located in Greenfield, is
3 hereby authorized, upon the approval of the
4 board of gas and electric light commissioners, to
5 carry on its business in the towns of Shelburne,
6 Buckland and Conway, or in any one or more
7 of said towns, with all the rights, powers and
8 privileges, and subject to all the duties and liabilities
9 in said Shelburne, Buckland and Conway
10 which now are or may be in force applicable to
11 such corporations.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
