AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Care and Maintenance of the Nantasket Beach and Charles River Reservations under the Control of the Metropolitan Park Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue,
4 to meet expenses during the year ending Decem-
5 ber thirty-first in the year nineteen hundred.

6 For care and maintenance of Nantasket beach
7 by the metropolitan park commission, a sum not
8 exceeding sixty-five hundred dollars. [Acts
9 1899, chap. 464.]

(No appropriation in 1899.)

10 For care and maintenance of the Charles river
11 reservation, including the Charles river, Neponset

12 river and the Mystic river, within the metropolitan
13 district, a sum not exceeding thirty-five hundred
14 dollars. [Acts 1900, chap. 340.]

(No appropriation in 1899.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
