AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Suppression of the
Gypsy Moth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding one hundred
2 thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be
3 paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth,
4 from the ordinary revenue, to be expended by
5 such person, persons or agents as the governor
6 and council may designate, under the direction
7 of the governor and council, subject to such rules
8 and regulations as they may prescribe, for the
9 suppression of the *ocneria dispar*, or gypsy moth,
10 during the year ending on the thirtieth day of
11 April, nineteen hundred and one.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of chapter two
2 hundred and ten of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-one, and acts in amendment
4 thereof and in addition thereto, shall apply to all
5 acts of such person, persons or agents as the
6 governor and council may designate to carry out
7 the provisions of this act.

1 SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts incon-
2 sistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
