AN ACT

To extend the Charter of the Barnstable County Street Railway Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section eight of chapter four hundred and sixty-  
2 eight of the acts of the year eighteen hundred  
3 and ninety-six, as amended by chapter two hun-  
4 dred and twenty of the acts of the year eighteen  
5 hundred and ninety-eight, is hereby amended by  
6 striking out the words "eighteen hundred and  
7 ninety-nine," in the last two lines thereof, and  
8 inserting in place thereof the words:—nineteen  
9 hundred,— so as to read as follows:—

10 *Section 8.* The provisions of this act shall  
11 become void so far as relates to the rights of said  
12 company if it shall not have constructed and put  
13 in operation at least five miles of railway prior to  
14 the first day of October in the year nineteen  
15 hundred.
