### AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Clerk of the Police Court of the City of Brockton, and to provide for Clerical Assistance in said court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the  
2 police court of the city of Brockton shall be thir-  
3 teen hundred dollars a year, to be so allowed from  
4 the first day of January in the year nineteen hun-  
5 dred

1 SECTION 2. The said clerk shall be allowed  
2 for clerical assistance, upon his certificate that the

3 work was actually performed and was necessary,  
4 with the time occupied and the name of the per-  
5 son by whom the work was performed, such sums,  
6 not exceeding two hundred dollars in any one  
7 year, as the county commissioners for the county  
8 of Plymouth by a writing signed by them may  
9 approve. Said sums shall be paid monthly from  
10 the treasury of said county to the person em-  
11 ployed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
