

[To accompany the petition of Edgar O. Achorn and others for legislation to provide that the salary of the assistant to the secretary of the State Board of Agriculture may be increased. Public Service.]

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Assistant to the Secretary of the Board of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section six, chapter four hundred and twelve
2 acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-one is hereby
3 amended by striking out the word "twelve" and
4 inserting in the place thereof the word: — seven-
5 teen, — so as to read as follows: —

6 *Section 6.* The governor, by and with the
7 consent of the council, shall appoint an assistant
8 to the secretary of the board of agriculture, at an
9 annual salary of seventeen hundred dollars, and
10 expenses necessarily incurred in the discharge of
11 his duties, to assist in the work prescribed in the
12 eleventh section of this act. Said appointee shall
13 hold office for two years or till his successor is
14 appointed, unless sooner removed from office by
15 the governor, and his successor shall be appointed
16 as above provided for.
