AN ACT

To authorize the Appointment of an Electrician and
an Assistant Engineer at the State Prison.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The warden of the state prison
2 may with the approval of the commissioners of
3 prisons appoint one electrician and one assistant
4 engineer at said prison.

1 SECTION 2. The said electrician and assist-
2 ant engineer shall perform such duties as may be
3 assigned to them by said warden; and they shall
4 be subject to all the obligations and penalties
5 now provided by law in regard to officers of said
6 prison.

1 SECTION 3. The salaries of the officers ap-
2 pointed under this act shall be fixed by the

3 warden with the approval of the commissioners
4 of prisons; the salary of the electrician shall not
5 exceed twelve hundred dollars a year, and the
6 salary of the assistant engineer shall not exceed
7 ten hundred dollars a year.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect January
2 first nineteen hundred and one.
