AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Removal of Wrecks from Tide Waters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of five thousand dollars
2 is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary
4 revenue, for expenses in connection with the re-
5 moval of wrecks and other obstructions from
6 tide-waters, as provided for in section nine of
7 chapter two hundred and sixty of the acts
8 of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
9 three, during the year ending on the thirty-first
10 day of December in the year nineteen hundred
11 and one.

(Appropriation 1900, \$5,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
