AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Massachusetts
School for the Feeble-minded.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of thirty-five thousand
2 dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordi-
4 nary revenue, to the Massachusetts school for the
5 feeble-minded, as provided for by chapter sixty-
6 six of the resolves of the year eighteen hundred
7 and ninety-eight.

(Appropriation 1900, \$35,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
