AN ACT

Relative to the Board of Railroad Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of railroad commis-  
2 sioners is hereby authorized to expend a sum  
3 not exceeding three thousand dollars annually  
4 in procuring necessary books, maps, statistics  
5 and stationery, and in defraying expenses in-  
6 cidental and necessary to the discharge of its  
7 duties. A statement of such expenditures shall  
8 accompany its annual report.

1 SECTION 2. So much of section ten of chap-  
2 ter one hundred and twelve of the public statutes

3 as is inconsistent with this act and chapter two  
4 hundred of the acts of the year eighteen hundred  
5 and ninety are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of section twelve  
2 of one hundred and twelve of the public statutes  
3 shall apply to the expenses authorized by this act.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
